FINAL INSTRUCTIONS NO.1

1. Thank you for your entry. Your Competition Number is detailed on the club website – www.omaghmotorclub.co.uk – and on the club's Facebook page.
2. Scrutiny is at Donnell & Ellis, Derry Road, Omagh, BT78 5NF between 6pm and 9.30pm on Friday 20th September.
3. A noise test will be carried out at the scrutiny venue. Competitors must report for the noise test prior to scrutineering. Noise testing may also be carried out during the event.
4. **At Scrutiny all competitors must produce** a Vehicle Registration document, an Motorsport UK/MI Log book, a current MOT/NCT certificate, and proof that the vehicle is currently taxed for use on the public road – **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Vehicles registered outside the UK are subject to the MOT regulations that apply in their country of origin. Cars must be presented with legal size number plates. Competition numbers must be in place before the car is presented for scrutiny. These will be available at the Scrutiny venue. Helmets, Clothing and Frontal Head Restraints must be produced for inspection. A maximum of two persons are permitted to accompany a car to scrutiny. Please be aware that there is a large entry for the event so timescales must be complied with.
5. Documentation will be immediately following Scrutineering and on Saturday morning at the Silverbirch Hotel. **Any competitor not signed on by 8am on Saturday 21st September may be excluded**. It is essential that timescales are complied with and where possible competitors should endeavour to complete their documentation on Friday evening.
6. A Trailer park is available at St.Enda's GAA Car Park, Gortin Road, Omagh on Saturday only. All trailers must be parked at this location. **Trailers will not be accepted in the Service Park**.
7. Service is in Aghyaran St. Davog's GAA Club, 5, Aghyaran Road, Castlederg, BT81 7YA. **The Service Park opens at 8.00am**. Please co-operate with the Service Park officials and minimise the working space that you require. **At documentation crews will be issued with a Service Plate which will admit one vehicle only to the Service Park. It will not be possible for this vehicle to leave the Service Park and then be re-admitted**. Auxiliary service vehicles, Service team members etc. should park in the Chapel car park behind Aghyaran GAA Club and access the Service Park via a walkway at the rear of the site.
8. Amendments to the Supplementary Regulations are as follows;
SR 3 - Motorsport UK Permit No. 114477 has been issued for the event.
SR 8 is modified to read – With the exception of Special Stage 3 cars will start at one-minute intervals. On Special stage 3 cars will return to the startline of

Special Stage 2 and be alternated into the running order on 30 second intervals with those starting Special Stage 2.

SR14 – Car Accountability – Replace Ursula Mullan by Denise McCanney

9. A **Driver's Briefing** will be held in the Drumragh Room of the Silverbirch Hotel at 8.40am on Saturday 21st September. All competitors **MUST** attend.
10. Breakfast is available in the Silverbirch Hotel from 6am to 9.30am. Dinner will be available after the event. Please support our sponsors.
11. **Please ensure that you are familiar with the SOS/OK procedure which is detailed in the front of the roadbook.**
12. The PSNI have been informed of the route so please ensure that you comply with all road traffic regulations.
13. **If you retire from the event please have your timecards ready for collection by the Tailsweep car.** Delaying the Tailsweep car while you look for your timecards can cause a delay in the rally time schedule.
14. **Trophy Rally:** This is a supplementary event to the main rally, which is being provided by the Organisers to permit Competitors who retire from the main event on Special Stages 1-5 the opportunity to have further competition. Vehicles **MUST** be re-scrutineered for conformity. This scrutineering will take place at the event service park. Competitors will re-start from the Service Out Control prior to Special Stage 6. Timecards will be issued by the Competitor Relations Officer upon completion of re-scrutiny. Competitors taking part on the Trophy Rally section will run behind the main event or may be re-seeded at the Clerk of the Course's discretion. Results will be displayed along with the results for the main event. There is no award for the Trophy Rally winner.
15. All Senior Officials named in these regulations and the following are deemed to be Judges of Fact in respect of illegal servicing and driving standards; Plunkett Boyle, Drew Wilson, Gerard McConnell, Larry Harper, Shane McAleer, Leslie Young and Richard Keys.
16. The Competitor Relations Officer is Gary Milligan. Gary will be available at Signing-on, the Start control, Service In controls, the Finish control and at the publication of provisional results.



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
