FINAL INSTRUCTIONS NO.1

1. Thank you for your entry. Your Competition Number is detailed on the club website – www.omaghmotorclub.co.uk – and on the club's Facebook page. Competitors should ensure that they are entered in the correct class on the entry list. Failure to do this may result in you being excluded from the results at the end of the event.
2. Scrutiny is at Fivemiletown College, 51 Colebrook Rd, Fivemiletown, BT75 0SB starting at 6pm on Friday 21st February 2020.

3. A noise test will be carried out at the scrutiny venue. Competitors must report for the noise test prior to scrutineering. Noise testing may also be carried out during the event.
4. **At Scrutiny all competitors must produce** a Vehicle Registration document, a Motorsport UK/MI Log book, a current MOT/NCT certificate, and proof that the vehicle is currently taxed for use on the public road – **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Vehicles registered outside the UK are subject to the MOT regulations that apply in their country of origin. Cars must be presented with legal size number plates. Competition numbers must be in place before the car is presented for scrutiny. These will be available at the Scrutiny venue. Helmets, Clothing and Frontal Head Restraints must be produced for inspection. A maximum of two persons are permitted to accompany a car to scrutiny. Please be aware that there is a large entry for the event so timescales must be complied with.
5. Documentation will be immediately following Scrutineering and on Saturday morning at Fivemiletown College. **Any competitor not signed on by 8am on Saturday 22nd February 2020 may be excluded.** It is essential that timescales are complied with and where possible competitors should endeavour to complete their documentation on Friday evening.
6. A Trailer park is available at Cooneen Group Factory Car Park, 23 Coonen Rd, Fivemiletown, BT75 0NE on Saturday only. All trailers must be parked at this location. **Trailers will not be accepted in the Service Park. Trailer park will close at 8pm Saturday 22nd February.**
7. Service is in Fivemiletown College, 51 Colebrook Rd, Fivemiletown, BT75 0SB. The Service Park opens at 6.00am. Please co-operate with the Service Park officials and minimise the working space that you require.

8. All crews must use ground sheets in the service area and keep their location tidy and clear of rubbish at all times. Rubbish bags will be provided to each crew to assist with this.
9. A Driver's Briefing will be held in the Assembly Hall in Fivemiletown College at 8.40 am on Saturday 22nd February. All competitors MUST attend.
10. Food will be available on Friday and all-day Saturday at Richard's Chip Wagon. All proceeds will be in aid of the Northern Ireland Air Ambulance, please support this worthy cause.
11. **Please ensure that you are familiar with the SOS/OK procedure which is detailed in the front of the roadbook.**
12. The PSNI have been informed of the route so please ensure that you comply with all road traffic regulations.
13. **If you retire from the event please have your timecards ready for collection by the Tailsweep car.** Delaying the Tailsweep car while you look for your timecards can cause a delay in the rally time schedule.
14. **Trophy Rally:** This is a supplementary event to the main rally, which is being provided at the organiser's discretion to permit Competitors who retire from the main event on Special Stages 1-4 the opportunity to have further competition. Vehicles MUST be re-scrutineered for conformity. This scrutineering will take place at the event service park. Competitors will re-start from the Service Out Control prior to Special Stage 5. Timecards will be issued by the Competitor Relations Officer upon completion of re-scrutiny. Competitors taking part on the Trophy Rally section will run behind the main event or may be re-seeded at the Clerk of the Course's discretion. Results will be displayed along with the results for the main event. There is no award for the Trophy Rally winner.
15. All Senior Officials named in these regulations and the following are deemed to be Judges of Fact in respect of illegal servicing and driving standards; Plunkett Boyle, Drew Wilson, Stephen O'Neill, Kevin Lynam, Brendan McCabe and Eddie Rafferty.
16. **If you become aware that you will be unable to compete in the event can you please advise the event secretary of your intention to withdraw ASAP. This is to allow crews on the reserve list the maximum time possible to prepare for the event.**
17. The Competitor Relations Officer is Gary Milligan.
Gary will be available at Signing-on, the Start control, Service In controls, the Finish control and at the publication of provisional results.



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
