FINAL INSTRUCTIONS NO 1

1. Thank you for your entry which has been accepted. Please check the entry list online at Rallyscore, or on Omagh Motor Club's Facebook page for your competition number. It was not possible to allocate everyone the number that they requested so please ensure that you have the correct number(s) on your car prior to Scrutiny. Numbers will not be provided by the organisers.

2. To avoid congestion in the paddock please approach the hill from Spamount village. For those approaching from Omagh turn right following the signpost for Victoriabridge/Castlederg which is 12.5 miles after the last roundabout on the Omagh Ring Road. For those approaching from Strabane turn left at the signpost for Victoriabridge/Castlederg which is 3.0 miles after the last roundabout on the Strabane Ring Road. In Victoriabridge follow the signpost for Castlederg. After 5.3 miles turn left at the signpost for Spamount. The paddock is on this road (Drumnabey Road) after 0.7 miles.

3. TRAILER PARKING will be available in a field in the paddock. Please use this facility to reduce congestion in the paddock.

4. SCRUTINY & Sound Testing will take place on Saturday 28th May between 8am and 9.30am in Gareth Sayers' Yard which is approximately half-way along the Paddock Area on the Drumnabey Road, Spamount. Vehicles will be checked for conformity with Motorsport UK regulations with regard to safety and general eligibility for the event. Motorsport UK / Motorsport Ireland logbooks should be available for inspection.

5. DOCUMENTATION will take place immediately following vehicle scrutineering and will involve the collection of a satisfactory vehicle scrutiny sheet, the inspection of licences and club membership.

6. If you are entered in Classes 8A, 8B, 9, 9B, or 12-15 please ensure that you have the appropriate competition licence. Four-wheel drive rally cars require a RS National Speed or Race licence unless the car is taxed and is competing in a road legal condition.

7. A Driver's Briefing will be held at the startline around 10am. Please make your way to the startline before this time so that the event can start on time.

8. The cars will be started in two batches;

Batch 1 – Dual entries and Classes 1 - 6B plus 16A and 16B

Batch 2 – Remaining Dual Entries and Classes 7 - 15.

9. Results will be available during the event on www.resultsman.co.uk in the McAleer Timing Events tab. Sector times will also be available on the results facility.

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10. The prize-giving will be immediately after the event at the scrutiny venue. Please make an effort to attend if you are a prizewinner. All classes will receive a minimum of 1st and 2nd in class awards.

11. In order to maintain a good relationship with the local residents a speed limit of 30mph on the return road and 15mph in the Paddock area must be maintained. Anyone exceeding this speed or driving in an irresponsible manner may be excluded from the event. In the interests of maintaining a good relationship with the local community please do not litter.
